Here's a chance for Adult Educators to present to their colleagues in a Round Robin format. It's a great opportunity for you to boast about something that works but wouldn't fill an hour long workshop. There are two possible types of presentations:

- An Adult Education program can staff a table where they will have 12 minutes to share recent program successes achieved in terms of increasing program enrollment, working with new or unique populations, significant or interesting funding successes and/or partnerships, or an exciting and creative program idea.
- If you are presenting a session as part of the Conference agenda, you have 12 minutes to present a "teaser" for your session. Let people know what your session will be about and inspire them to talk it up and encourage attendance.

In the 12 minutes you will have the opportunity to share this information and dialogue with participants as they move from table to table until they've met with each program. This is a fun and interactive forum to gain insight from each other, share strategies and ideas, and begin networking opportunities for during and after the conference.

If selected to be a presenter, your program's overview will be printed as a handout for participants.

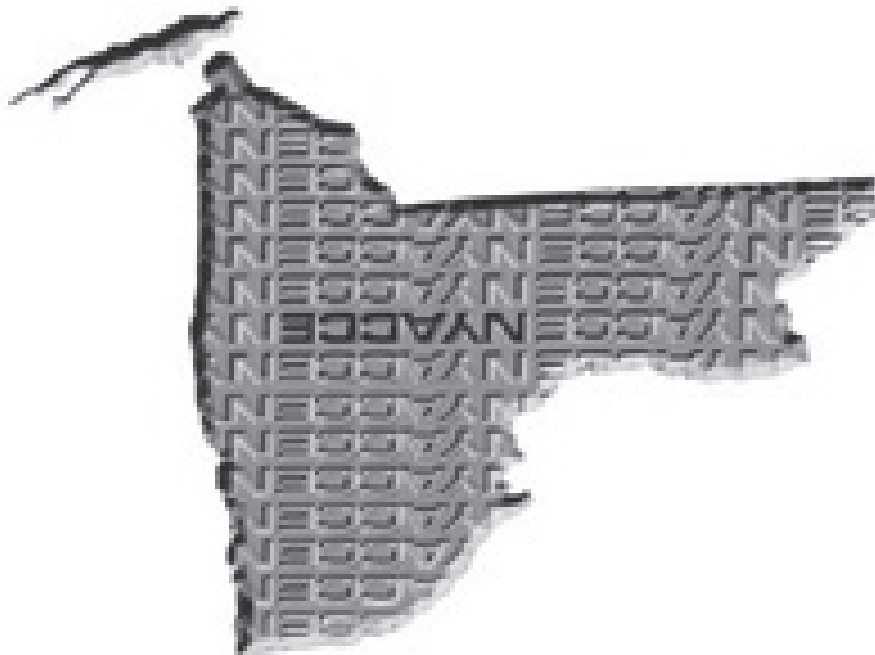
If you are interested in your program participating in the Opening Session please submit a one page summary including:
