



The President's Scholarship

Description of the Award:

A \$250.00 scholarship is available annually to one recipient to support higher education.

Eligibility:

The candidate must be a member, or immediate family member* of a NYACCE member in good standing. *Immediate family member may be the son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, spouse, parent, brother, sister of the NYACCE member in good standing (dues must be current).

Criteria:

The scholarship is competitive, reviewed by committee and awarded to one person annually. It is based on quality of candidate response in writing to a selected essay topic on the subject of lifelong learning. The essay must be post-marked and returned by the stated deadline, and must address the stated topic. All candidates must sign a release allowing NYACCE to reprint their essay in LINKS, the NYACCE newsletter.

Funding to support the scholarship program is made available through private donations and NYACCE fundraising activities. Donations are gladly accepted.
